MENTORING

Attending a CCR consultation for the first time can sometimes be a confusing experience and therefore the CCR executive has decided to implement a mentor program. People who are new to CCR consultations will be given the name of a person experienced in the ways of the CCR who will assist the newcomer to understand the CCR processes and where the newcomer can fit in. First time attendees and their mentors will be introduced to each other at the orientation session to be held on the first morning of the consultation. To assist in this process we are asking participants to indicate if you are attending for the first time or if you are willing to act as a mentor.

REFUGEE PARTICIPATION

The CCR is committed to promoting refugee participation. Refugees without an organization that could pay their registration fee can register free of charge. Refugee participants must fill in a registration form, marking it REFUGEE PARTICIPANT, and send it in to the CCR office **by Friday 21 May**.

POPULAR THEATRE WORKSHOP

Participants in the popular theatre workshop will be expected to attend the full workshop (Tuesday 25 May and Wednesday 26 May, 10am to 6pm) and the Forum Theatre on Thursday 27 May in the morning (at the opening plenary). Participants should be refugee advocates, involved in refugee protection, sponsorship or settlement, and ideally should be active within the CCR.
