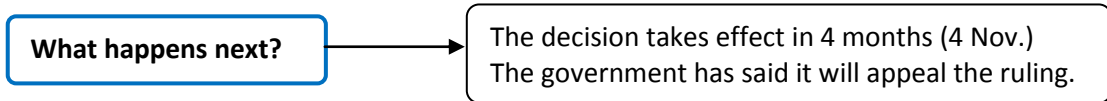
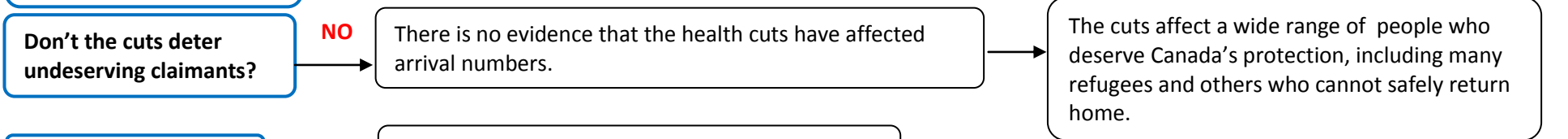
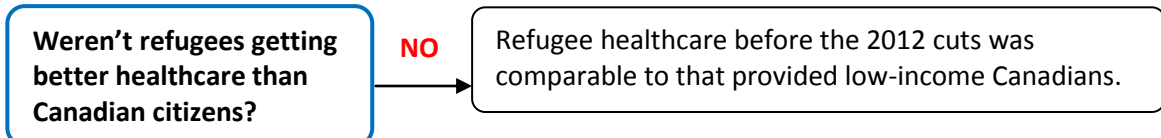
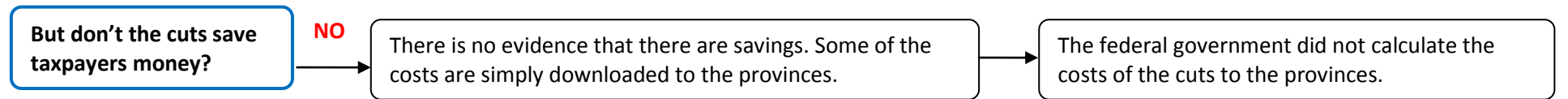
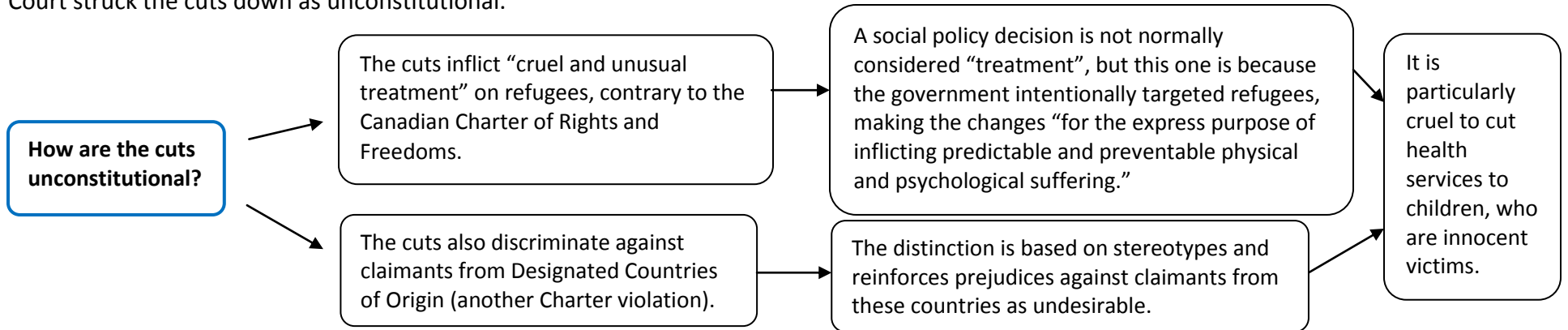




Refugee health care cuts: a quick review of the Federal Court decision
