Dear Member of Parliament

Welcoming refugees is fundamental to Canadian values. Our communities are strengthened and lives are saved when we open our doors to refugees from around the world.

Yet recent cuts to the immigration levels have severely limited our community's generosity and denied safety to thousands of refugees. Since 2023, refugee resettlement levels have been cut by 43%, compared to 18% for immigration levels overall.

We have the will, the capacity and the expertise to welcome and resettle more refugees.

I'm calling on you to support a target of 15% of immigration levels for resettled refugees (Government-Assisted and Privately Sponsored) - compared to 8% in 2026.

We know that **we are better together** and that none of us is safe until all of us are safe.
