



The Canadian government will soon be deciding on how many refugees and immigrants Canada will admit in 2017, 2018 and 2019.




How can we better meet the global need for resettlement?

Canadians can add to the numbers of refugees resettled to Canada through private sponsorship but the government also needs to do its part through a strong government assistance program.

Until recently, the government has been resettling fewer and fewer refugees.

Canadians want to know that their government is fulfilling its international responsibility, on behalf of all Canadians, to protect refugees through resettlement.

Canada can and should accept a minimum of 20 000 Government Assisted Refugees a year.
