

A Tulip for Refugees

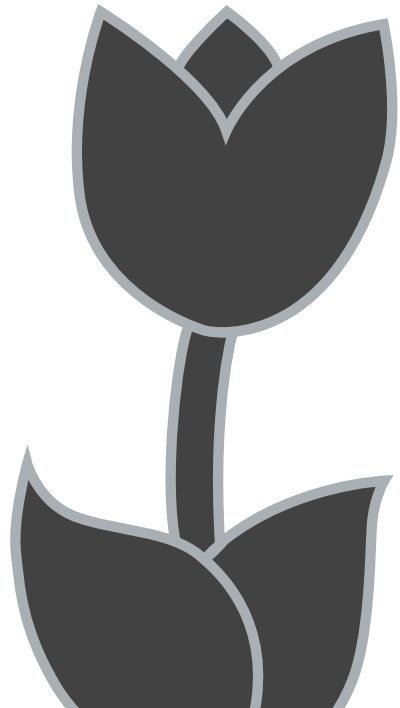
