For more than 40 years, CCR Consultations have been held successfully twice a year in different cities across Canada. The Consultation is a 3-day event, involving approximately 30 sessions: workshops, plenary sessions, youth orientations, working group meetings, caucus and networking sessions. The Consultation will offer key opportunities for information exchange, networking, and strategy development. Its format allows participants to learn from discussions and actively contribute to them.

The last Consultation was held virtually due to the pandemic in May 2020, gathering 1000 participants with common objectives to strengthen cross-border networking, collaboration and knowledge exchange among NGOs committed to the rights of refugees and vulnerable migrants.
